

## Fee/Dues Schedule

LPMA powered by Interchange 360 has established a fee/dues schedule that is intended fund the Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) program in each state.

**Planning Fees** are intended to fund the activities needed for program start-up, including development of the EPR Plan, engagement with state EPR leads, engagement with stakeholders, preparation of an operational plan, IT, communications, legal and administration. Planning Fees stop when Implementation Fees begin.

*Implementation Fees* are intended to fund the operation of the program including payments to service providers, infrastructure development, public communications, state oversight costs, legal, IT and administration.

Fees are expected to change based on the eco-modulation requirements of each state, including requirement for Post Consumer Recycled content and recyclability. Fees are also expected to be regularly assessed and adjusted as program costs become better understood. Fees apply to all petroleum and petroleum related packaging up to 15 gallons.

The timing of fee start varies by state and is impacted by the amount of effort required to meet the different program planning and development process in each state.
